The site-specific and equipment specific requirements for training in the workplace, tips on how to develop training addressing adult learning styles and generational differences, and all guidelines required by OSHA are emphasized in the Forklift Train-the-Trainer Guide Manual and course support on DVD.

Each forklift operator you train can receive a wallet-size laminated certification card (see pricing list below) from MSSC if the proper paperwork is submitted to us. Montana Safety Services also keeps an updated database of companies forklifts trained on, if it is noted on the roster returned to our office.
