



OSHA Audits and Compliance

- electrical issues

- fire extinguishers
- eye wash stations
- pallet lifting / ladder issues
- stair and loft storage construction issues
- rag usage and disposal issues
- emergency lighting
- exits
- first aid kit issues
- compressed cylinders / tanks
- compressed air usage
- hazardous waste capture / storage and labeling
- air quality, and many other issues.

After the audit is completed, MSSC will conduct an executive review with management and your safety program administrator to present our findings and recommendations so that you will know what you need to implement at your facility to improve the safety of your workplace and to attain 100% OSHA / Fire Safety compliance.
